Call for Posters for the 2026 Nasal Innovation Forum

The IPAC-RS 2026 Nasal Innovation Forum to be held on Wednesday – Thursday, September 16-17, 2026, in Jersey City, New Jersey is inviting abstract submissions for posters as described below.

Poster Abstracts

Individuals and groups interested in presenting posters should email an informative abstract to the IPAC-RS Secretariat (info@ipacrs.org) **before April 15, 2026**, with the words 'Poster Abstract for IPAC-RS 2026 Nasal Innovation Forum in the subject line. A final decision about acceptance or non-acceptance of a proposed poster will be communicated to the corresponding author by **May 31, 2026**.

The content of abstracts should be sufficiently detailed to allow the organizers to assess the suitability of the proposed poster for this Forum. Abstracts should follow the template provided on the last page of this Call for Posters.

Abstracts of accepted posters will be posted before the Forum on the Forum website. A pdf version of the final poster will be posted on the Forum website after the Forum concludes. ***By submitting an abstract for the IPAC-RS 2026 Nasal Innovation Forum, the authors give permission for their abstracts (if accepted) to be posted on the IPAC-RS Forum website.***

Poster Content

Posters may not be of a commercial or promotional nature.

Posters should convey sound scientific work within the scope of the Forum as reflected in the Forum Program and themes (see below). Sample topics of interest include:

- Device Selection
- Manufacturing Best Practices
- Pre IND to CTM Roadmap
- Regulatory Pathway
- Patient Perspectives

Best Posters

Forum attendees will be asked to vote on the best posters. The top three posters will be announced during the morning of Day 2 of the Forum [9/17/26]. Winning poster authors will have 10-15 minutes that morning (9/17/26) to give a short presentation on their poster.

Template for Poster Abstracts for IPAC-RS 2026 Nasal Innovation Forum

GENERAL FORMAT:

Abstracts should be provided as MS Word files formatted to 'Letter'-sized (8½" x 11") paper in 'Portrait' layout with 1-inch margins all around. If the authors wish to submit abstracts as a 'PDF' file, then the corresponding author's contact information should be omitted from the abstract and should be supplied in a separate document or via email. Abstracts should be no longer than 1 page.

STYLE:

Poster Title

(For Poster Title, use Arial Font Bold, font size 12, Title Case)

Robin Smith¹ and Tom Johnson²

(For Authors, use Arial Font Regular, font size 12, underlined. Include the full first and full last names)

¹*Company, City, Country*

²*University, City, Country*

(For Author Affiliations, use Arial Font Italics, font size 10. Include the company's name and location. Do NOT include here any further identifying information, such as phones or email addresses)

For text of the abstract, use Arial Font Regular, font size 10, single-spaced, justified. Page margins should be 1 inch (2.5 cm) all around. You may include figures, graphs, references or footnotes but the total length should not exceed 1 page. Do not indent paragraphs but leave extra space between paragraphs.

Do not use page or paragraph borders. The box around this text is meant to highlight the portion of accepted submissions that will appear on the IPAC-RS website.

ADDITIONAL CONTACT INFORMATION TO BE SUBMITTED WITH THE POSTER ABSTRACT:

When submitting the abstract, please include the complete contact information of the corresponding author (name, title, company, phone, email, postal address). This contact information will NOT be posted on the Forum website.
